Over the past three decades, Adriana Hoyos' warm, sophisticated aesthetic has enriched spaces in the United States, South America, the Caribbean, France and the United Kingdom. Her impressive roster of projects includes the Vanderbilt Mansion in Fisher Island; Aqualina Cable Beach in the Bahamas; Tower 10 in Doral; and hotel interiors for Starwood, Hilton and Marriott. In addition, Hoyos has unveiled 13 furniture collections since 2003—each with different design inspiration. Her company, headquartered in Miami (with manufacturing facilities in Quito, Ecuador), employs more than 300 people.
